Church Membership

At Cornerstone Church we invite people to become church members. The Bible tells us that when we believe in Jesus Christ we become members of his family. It also says that we are members of his body – that we are all joined to each other and have an important part to play. Church membership is our way of inviting you to express this connection and commitment to Christ through a local church. We believe every Christian is called to be an active and vital part of a local church.



Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it (1 Corinthians 12:27)

In human organisations, to be a member you pay a fee and expect a benefit. In church membership, Jesus has made a massive payment - offering his life for us. We activate our membership by serving Jesus through his body – the local church.

What do I need to do to be a member?

You need to be a committed Christian – you have given your life over to Jesus Christ – and you have been baptised to demonstrate that commitment. Members need to be 18 years of age.

What is expected of members

1. Be on board with the vision and direction we have as a church.

2. Be a part of our community, by being at our gatherings and being proactive in building relationships with others.

 Be on team, by finding places to volunteer and use the passions and gifts that God has put in you. This can happen on Sundays or with week day programs.
Be committed to giving financially, to support the work of the church.

Is there a formal role?

Yes, our church members are also official members of our incorporated body as a not-for-profit religious charity and are therefore called to participate and vote on some matters.

If you love and follow Jesus and want to be an active part of a local church, we encourage you to become a church member.
